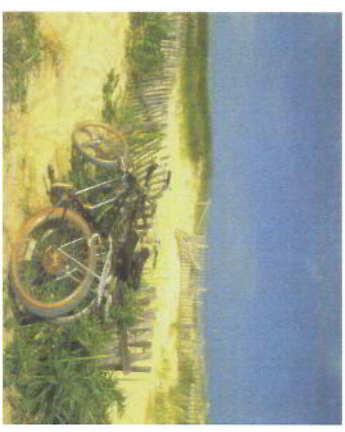

We will stop at the **Kennedy Memorial** overlooking Lewis Bay. Later today we will visit the **JFK Museum** in Hyannis. This museum captures the years JFK spent at the family compound in Hyannis Port—his time with family and friends, and with national and international persons of prominence, and we will get to find out why he was so drawn to Cape Cod. This evening we will enjoy a wonderful farewell **Lobster Dinner**.
